EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

ADMISSION OF HORSES: Horses will be admitted no earlier than noon on Wednesday. Rings will be available to work starting on Thursday morning. All horses must be removed by 8 p.m. Sunday.

ARENA POLICY: Lunging will not be allowed in the warm up ring while any session is going on. During regular work times, horses being ridden or driven will have the right of way over those being lunged.

BEDDING: No first bedding will be provided per stall. Shavings will be available at \$11 per bag from the show office. No outside bedding allowed. No fiberboard or stall mats except through Show Time Stall Mats.

STALL MATS: Order stall mats on your entry form.

TACK VENDOR: Contact Horse Emporium 262-549-5422 for any tack/supply requests

CAMPING: Campsites will be available in a designated camping area at \$30 per night. Please indicate the nights you will be camping on your entry blank, and pay for your permit with your entries. Be sure to clearly display your permit on your camper. Space is limited, and you must reserve ahead.

CLASS HOLD POLICY: In order to put together an accurate, predictable time schedule, class holds must be requested in writing no less than one hour prior to the start of the session. Please use class hold request forms at the show office. Anyone with special requests for more than the standard two-minute hold must make special arrangements with the show manager no less than two hours before the session in which the class will be held.

DOGS: Dogs must be on leashes at all times or in tack stalls and tied away from doorways.

ENTRY BLANKS: Entry blanks must be signed by the owner or agent, exhibitor and trainer. Entry blanks must be completed in full and accompanied with full payment. Make checks payable to Mid-States Morgan Horse Club Inc.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: ALL HORSES must have a negative Coggins test within the last six months. In addition, horses must comply with the USEF vaccination rules.

QUESTIONS, DISPUTES, PROTESTS: The Prairie State Classic will be run in accordance with USEF rules, but is not a member show. All disputes will be handled by the show manager. All decisions made by the judge in the show ring will be final.

OFFICE PROCEDURES

SHOW SECRETARY: Show packets may be picked up in the show secretary's office beginning on Thursday at noon. BE SURE TO MAIL YOUR ENTRIES BY THE MAY 10 DUE DATE. Online entries may be made at HorseShowsOnline.com. Entries made after May 10 will be charged a \$25 post entry fee.

HOURS: The office will CLOSE one hour before each session to prepare the judge's cards and class sheets. The office will reopen at the start of the first class of a session and close at the conclusion of the last class of that session. Entries close one hour before each scheduled session. No exceptions.

REFUNDS: Refunds will be made only when a veterinarian's certificate is presented before the start of the show. Refunds for entry fees only will be made if said certificate is received after the start of the show. Once the horse is on the grounds, ONLY the official veterinarian may issue said certificate. Stall fees and office fees cannot be refunded.

SCRATCHES: Exhibitors must notify the secretary's office of scratches. A \$20 fee may be assessed to any exhibitor that does not notify the office.

POST-ENTRIES: There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse on entries postmarked after show entry closing date of May 13, 2024.

RETURNED CHECKS: Any check returned because of insufficient funds will be charged a \$50 fee. The \$SO fee and the amount for which the check was written must be paid with a cashier's or certified check.

AWARDS: A trophy and eight ribbons will be awarded in all classes.

SAFETY REGULATIONS: The fire marshal and the facility owner will be checking all extension cords at the show. They must be UL approved (the large green or orange cords). All others will be removed. To ensure the safety and comfort of the horses, management reserves the right to unplug any devices if the electrical system becomes overloaded. Priority will always be given to maintaining power for essential equipment, such as horse cooling fans.

SINGLE-BIT DIVISION

Single-bit classes are open to riders in a snaffle bit only (no curb bits or curb chains allowed), with a running martingale, German martingale or draw rein. All tack should be of show ring quality. Riders are to wear appropriate show ring attire. The same horse/rider combination may not cross enter into another division with the exception of the In Hand, Showmanship and Pattern Classes. The same horse/rider combination may not compete in both the W/T and W/T/C sections of the Single Bit division

ACADEMY DIVISION

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a fun horse show atmosphere. The UPHA Chapters 3/4 and 10 sanction these classes. A complete copy of the guidelines will be available at the horse show office.

RIDERS: Riders in this division are students enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riders may NOT cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes. A rider who has shown in a regular division class and/or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from further participation in the academy division with the exception of the open rider pleasure classes (if applicable).

ACADEMY DIVISION CONTINUED

RIDER ATTIRE: All riders are encouraged to use safety helmets. ASTM/SEI approved safety helmets are the only acceptable headgear for academy riders. Helmets are required for ALL riders ages 10 and under. Saddle seat attire: Jodhpurs or dark pants, shirt with a collar, tie, Jodhpur boots or sturdy shoes. Sweater vest or fitted vest permitted; no derbies/hats. No full riding suits.

ACADEMY HORSES: Horses are to be lesson-type horses and must display characteristics of such! Instructors are encouraged to own or lease their academy horses. Horses must not be in training. Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with martingale or pelham/full bridle. Appropriate saddles are to be used for the seat being ridden. Hoof blacking and ribbon braids are optional. Academy horses may cross-enter into other divisions at any show; however, show horses may not be entered in the academy division.

CHAMPIONSHIP WORKOUTS: Walk/trot classes may call for workouts 1-3 below. Three gaited classes may call for workouts 1-8 below.

- 1. Stand up in a posting position, and hold the position until the judge says to sit. Hands may be on the saddle.
- 2. The judge can ask some riders to go back to the rail and do a workout around the ring at a walk/trot, reverse and walk/trot, etc., and then return to the lineup.
- 3. Trot a straightaway showing a change of diagonals; the rider must start on the correct diagonal.
- 4. Trot down the straightaway to the end, stop, reverse and canter back.
- 5. On a straightaway, trot halfway on the correct diagonal, stop and canter the remaining distance on the correct lead.
- 6. Trot a figure eight or trot a serpentine.
- 7. Canter down the straightaway, stop and then ride a circle at a trot.
- 8. Trot down the straightaway, stop and canter a circle

STICK HORSE CLASS: Enter at the show office. Participants will be directed where to join in the fun and given a stick horse. Entry fee: \$25. 100% of the entry fees collected for this class will go to our charity.

111. Open Advanced Leadline 8 and Under:

- 1. All riders are led in the class at the walk down the first rail.
- 2. Riders line up in a single file line down the second rail.
- 3. Riders are then individually led at the trot (English riders expected to post but correct diagonals NOT required) down the rail going first direction.

- 5. Riders reverse, and each rider trots down the rail the second direction.
- 6. All riders line up in the middle after everyone completes the workout. The judge walks the lineup and ties the class.
